The tragic fire and loss of life at Tazreen Fashions in November 2012 was a wakeup call for the government of Bangladesh and various stakeholders to focus attention on fire safety issues. Since that date, and the Rana Plaza disaster, which followed soon after, considerable progress has been made to address safety in Bangladesh with much emphasis placed on what in all reality, was and still remains the number one threat to life: fire. The International Labour Organization's 'Improving Fire and General Building Safety in Bangladesh' project funded by the US Department of Labour has made a major contribution in this regard. Through its efforts, significant headway has been made in building the capacity of the Fire Service and Civil Defence department. The fire service is now well on its way to realizing its goal of modernization and having the capacity to provide the services society requires. Significant work has also been undertaken to help create a more solid regulatory foundation upon which future safety efforts can be built. The project contributed greatly to the harmonisation of inspection standards and remediation protocols for RMG factories. In the aftermath of Rana Plaza this work was vitally important as a number of initiatives sought to rapidly carry out inspections of RMG factories for structural, electrical and fire safety.





The finance ministry has recently agreed to fund the Taka 5,000/-crore project to be implemented by the police. Under the new project, police will install 50,000 closed-circuit television (CCTV) cameras and motion sensors across the capital. Even at homes the use of security camera is increasing significantly in Bangladesh. The fire-fighting sector of Bangladesh is also experiencing significant growth. There were only 193 fire stations in the country before the Awami League-led government came to power in 2009. Now there are 335 fire stations and the number is expected to be 554 within a few months! Firefighters are now capable of managing large fire incidents as the fire service has been upgraded with modern equipment and the demand for new technology is still increasing. The demand for other security products such as fingerprint scanner, retina scanner, voice recognition, face recognition, anti-

malware, encryptions etc.



INDUSTRIES SECTOR RECORD BREAKING GDP GROWTH

Standing on the shoulders of the country's industries sector, Bangladesh is on the verge of achieving a new record in GDP growth for Fiscal Year (FY) 2017-18. According to Bangladesh Bureau of Statistics (BBS) data, Bangladesh will achieve a GDP growth of 7.65% in the current FY, exceeding an earlier prediction of 7.4%. The data also confirmed that the industries sector is the key driver of this projected growth. Planning Minister AHM Mustafa Kamal highlighted the growth in the industries sector during at a meeting of the Executive Committee of the National Economic Council (Ecnec).

The growth of the industries sector for this fiscal has been predicted to be 11.99%, according to data presented by the minister at the meeting. BBS data show that the industries sector had witnessed 10.22% growth the previous fiscal year.

At present, the sector's contribution to GDP exceeds 32%. There are nearly a million small and medium enterprises (SME) in Bangladesh. The contribution of these SMEs to GDP is an estimated 23%.




